



Ticket Subsidy Request Form 2021-2022 Season

Arts Factor is an initiative designed to increase access to live performances at The Mendel Center among underserved members of our community. We work with local service organizations to identify young people, families, seniors, individuals with disabilities, and others who would benefit from educationally and socially enriching activities. Recipient organizations receive free or significantly reduced-price tickets. The tickets distributed through the Arts Factor program are funded by donations from individuals and corporations. The number of tickets distributed per show and per season depends on the availability and funding. Requests are processed in the order they are received.

Please keep in mind:

- Recipient organizations are responsible for arranging and funding their own transportation. This could entail group transportation or individual participants arriving separately.
- Arts Factor tickets cannot be resold or used as a prize in a raffle, silent auction, etc.
- Do not request more tickets than you are confident you can use. Tickets going unused may affect your chances of receiving tickets in the future.
- Recipients are required to submit reflections or thank you notes from at least 50% of participants. This
 could be a note, photo, drawing, or anything else! We use these to attract more financial support to
 sustain the program, and we personally love to hear how the recipients enjoyed their experience!
- Not all shows are appropriate for all audiences. Because Arts Factor serves adults as well as children,
 not all of the shows available for Arts Factor tickets are child-friendly. Please research the show in
 advance or contact The Mendel Center staff for guidance on choosing appropriate shows for your
 participants.
- If you are awarded reduced-price tickets (as opposed to free tickets), the tickets will not be printed until we receive payment in full.
